

- focusing equally on technical outcomes and building knowledge, desire and leadership capabilities for sustainable urban change

Collaboratively deliver transition strategy, manage challenges, review impact, embed learning, celebrate achievements



Data translated into an Index outcome & insights report





# Urban Change Readiness Index Overall outcome by LGA









"Urban sprawl will lead to the detriment of Ballarat. We need more well-considered apartment buildings to deal with the rise in population"

"Mostly detached housing will not meet population needs, and will put undue strain on the environment. Medium and higher density is part of the solution, and it needs to be done without creating any social or environmental issues"









# Urban Transition

Leadership Capabilities

Need to add QR code

#### **SELF**

Authentic, transparent communication, an ability to read and respond appropriately to different reactions to change.



#### **SYSTEM**

Knowledge of how the urban change system works, the role and power of different actors and the specific levers you have influence over in your role.

#### **POLITICS**

Ability to understand and influence dynamic relationships between communities, organisations and elected members and work across political and sectoral interests to achieve solutions

#### **PLACE**

Understand principles of great urban outcomes and what needs to be in place to achieve them.

#### **STRATEGY**

Ability to collaboratively develop and execute urban change management strategies in a complex, often contested environment.



#### **CHANGE**

Ability to shape generative conversations on how to navigate the changing urban identity of neighbourhoods and realise the benefits of growth.
